The Nikos Kazantzakis Museum in Myrtia (Crete) (First private author museum in Greece)



"The family of my father ", Kazantzakis wrote, "originates from a village named "Varvari ". In this village, today named Myrtia, is the museum Nikos Kazantzakis. It is located about 9 miles away from Iraklion; to be reached over Knossos - Skalani - Myrtia. The 2008 renovated and newly arrange museum is in the midst of the village at the village square.
